## Blue Room Available for Rentals

With the help of a number of volunteers, the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Blue Room is now completed.

The Blue Room was named for the original blue crystal chandelier that once hung from the ceiling in the proprietor's dining room.

During the buildings various renovations, the room was rescued from a dilapidated state to a useable room with a contemporary blue colour scheme. The original Pine floor was severely damaged during the unauthorized demolition of the original rear extension. The room measures 14' x 16'.

The manager of the Rona store on Dundas Street, west of the Humber River, donated a large quantity of high quality laminate flooring to us. This flooring was installed this summer. Further, the workmen were able to repair and set up our large 10' conference table donated many years ago. We also have cloth chairs donated by the same individual. Historic pictures of the immediate area adorn the walls.

Heritage York is now ready to rent the Blue Room as our premiere meeting room and work area for research. We can provide a business environment for your meeting in an historic setting on the banks of the historic Humber River. The room includes a 5' LCD screen for presentations, as well as access to high-speed wireless Internet.
